How our education never touches the mind of the students and because it is subjected. The minds and hearts of the students should be understood.

Vivekananda's belief of education "Education is the manifestation of the perfection already in man." has been very beautifully explained by citing some interesting examples. The story of Janaka and Jagyabalka has also been discussed in his lecture. The power and importance of 'Soul' is reflected in the lecture. Srinivasa's principle of teaching also explained by the speaker.

Indian education has three parts - a methodised organisation of life (external and internal life), vast and ~~into~~ astonishing ^{fund of} integral knowledge and (Self Knowledge, God Knowledge, ~~World~~ ^{social} Knowledge) and Human potentialities and perfectivity. All these principles of Indian education come from Vivekananda and Anand.

Resource person Hiten Raishya gave a brief overview of the WWF INDIA ~~and the~~ an NGO working towards the conservation of elephants, tigers & rhinoceros in the region. He talked about the status of Asian elephants in ~~the~~ India. The demographics of elephant population of elephants in Assam was elaborately discussed. The various challenges in elephant conservation and the need for different approaches were stressed. He pointed out that elephants are extremely social and emotional creature who are no different than human being. The large scale habitat loss of elephants lead to mass man-animal conflicts in the past years. ~~Talk~~ Taking responsibilities by various stakeholders is need of the hour. Accidental electrocution, train hit lead to the loss of many numbers of the wild animal. Pesticides drained into various water bodies inside tea gardens also lead to lead to elephant ~~die~~ casualties. He concluded with the steps forward in conserving this beautiful creature and urged the students to be vigilant in their locality.

In the next talk, resource person Arjun Kandar talked ~~at~~ about 'Snakes in Assam'. It was an interactive session where students and faculties interacted with the speaker. The demography of various species of snakes in Assam. ~~#~~ Not all snakes are venomous and killing them is not a wise idea as it can cause ecological ^{imb}balance.

In the third talk lecture, the resource person talked about Train-Elephant collisions and mitigation measures. ^{one of the} Major causes of elephant death is ^{due to} train-hit. There are few hot-spots of elephant deaths due to train-hit. The speaker showed various video-footage of the movement of elephants to students. She stressed on various innovative precautionary measures in mitigating such accidents.

In the fourth lecture, the resource person talked on the topic "Community Conserved Areas in Western Arunachal Pradesh". He stressed on the importance of Arunachal Pradesh which has a huge biodiversity, and most part of it is covered by forest of which 75% of the forest belong to the local communities. He urged students to get involved in conservation efforts of their organization.

In the final talk, Dr Gitantha Kaushik presented on the topic "Understanding of carbon dioxide, and green house gases." He gave a very scientific understanding of the climate or green house effect due to the climate change. In the interactive session
